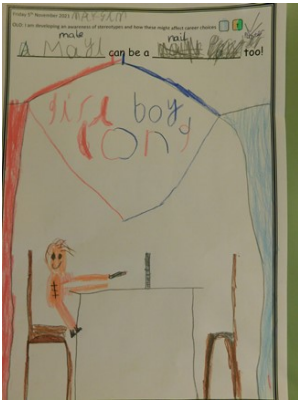
Library Visit
